



LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

Federal Aviation Administration Safety Team and Society of Aviation and Flight Educators

This Letter of Understanding (LOU) establishes an arrangement between the Federal Aviation Administration Safety Team (FAASTeam) and The Society of Aviation and Flight Educators (SAFE) to promote aviation safety awareness and training to all airmen. This LOU does not create a legal or financial obligation between the undersigned parties, or any liability on behalf of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) or any of its employees operating within the scope of their employment in connection with any activities conducted or events held pursuant to this agreement. Neither the FAA nor the FAASTeam endorses any entity, service, or product by entering into this agreement. The parties to this LOU enter into this agreement voluntarily to pursue a common goal of promoting aviation safety. Either party may terminate this LOU at any time by giving written notice to the other party.

The following reflects the duties and responsibilities agreed to by the undersigned parties under the LOU in support of aviation safety.

The FAASTeam agrees to:
