

Master Instructor Worksheet (Get started now!)

If you have been an instructor (flight or ground) for years, you probably *already* have the necessary experience to qualify to be designated a **Master Instructor**. The challenge is organizing and documenting those activities for our volunteer reviewers in an online file. Here is a simple worksheet to get you started. Most any aviation activity falls into one of these categories. Think hard and scribble your activities during the last two years in these 5 categories: (then dig up documentation for each!)

Educator (Applicant teaching) e.g. *flight reviews, sign-offs, taught club safety meeting?*

Continuing Education (Applicant learning) e.g. *new rating, IPC, WINGS training, FIRC?*

Service (Applicant helping others) e.g. *Young Eagles, Angel Flight, CAP, scouts?*

Creator of Media e.g. *lesson plans, pre-solo quiz, ppt, YouTube, blog or website?*

Participant e.g. *aircraft owner, SnF, OSH, aviation conference, EAA Chapter?*
